Objectives

- **Promote a Safety Culture**: Foster an organizational culture that prioritizes health and safety.
- **Provide Ongoing Training**: Offer continuous health and safety training for all colleagues.
- Enhance Emergency Preparedness: Improve readiness for emergencies.

Our Guiding Principles

- **Commitment from Leadership**: Leaders should visibly support and participate in health and safety programs and initiatives.
- **Compliance and Best Practices**: Regularly review compliance with laws and standards, and benchmark against industry leaders to adopt best practices.
- **Risk Management**: Conduct regular assessments, implement control measures, and review their effectiveness.

- **Employee Involvement and Accountability**: Encourage employee participation in safety committees, solicit feedback, and ensure accountability at all levels.
- **Communication and Awareness**: Create an open environment where employees feel comfortable reporting hazards, incidents, and near misses, and providing feedback on health and safety matters.
- **Continuous Improvement**: Continuously evaluate and enhance health and safety performance.
